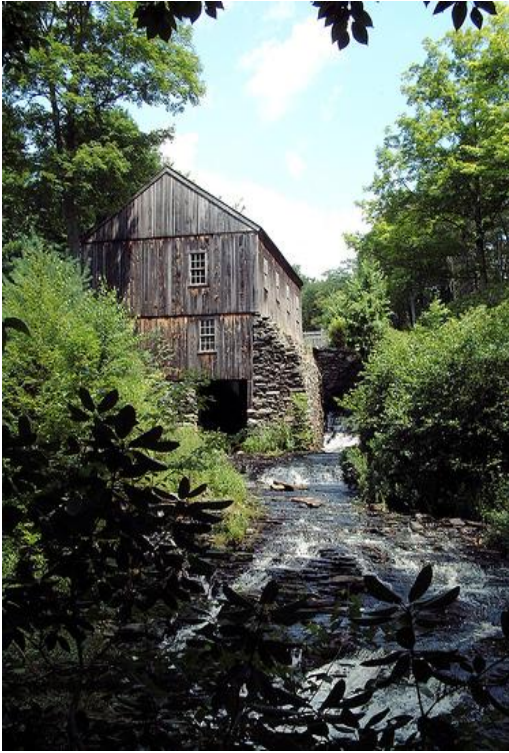


# Moore State Park
