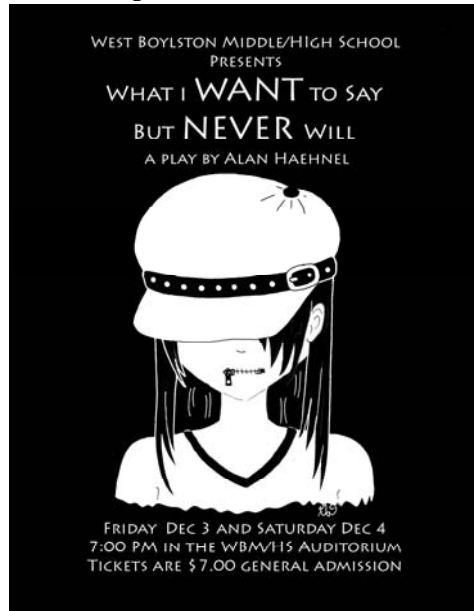


# WBHS Theater
